Dear Assemblyman Garrick,

I am writing to thank for your sponsorship of Sara's Law. I am well aware of what happened to Sara Cole on 9/9/07. Her life and her children's lives will never be the same. Since then, I have become more aware of the increasing number of victims who are injured, maimed or killed every year by illegal immigrants driving under the influence of alcohol.
